- **Job Description:** Seeking a Licensed Professional Engineer to support the Regional Traffic Engineer and the Regional Operations organization. The selected candidate will manage the planning, scheduling, and utilization of resources for project planning, review and design of traffic control plans and traffic engineering projects. This position is responsible for signing and sealing professional engineering plans. The selected candidate will also supervise a staff of engineering technicians as well as work closely with designers, consultants, local government, and other VDOT staff to effectively implement various VDOT programs.
- **Minimum Qualifications:** Demonstrated knowledge of transportation and traffic engineering principles and practices. Demonstrated work experience in contract management, scheduling, and administration. Demonstrated work experience with traffic engineering project planning, and the review and design of traffic control plans. Ability to read and interpret highway construction and traffic plans; to analyze complex problems and exercise independent judgment in reaching a solution; to communicate effectively orally and in writing with diverse groups across a diverse geographical region; to prioritize a large and varied workload with multiple time sensitive deadlines. Demonstrated work experience with supervision of staff, human resource programs, and performance management. Familiar with the Federal Highway Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices. Familiar with Pedestrian and Bicycle regulations as they apply to field implementation.
- **Preferred Qualifications:** Degree in civil engineering with course work in traffic engineering. Experience managing staff, projects and budgets. Experience managing a large workload in an engineering environment and working with local governments, elected officials, citizens, and engineering consultants is a plus.
- **Special Requirements:**

 - This position is designated as essential and as such, all duties associated with this position are required during emergency situations, which may include, but are not limited to inclement weather, disaster response, and emergency operations. VDOT will determine when essential positions are required.

- Professional Engineers License is required.
- Valid Drivers License, DMV Records check to be performed by the Department.
- Criminal History Records check and Fingerprint check required.
- Completion of a Statement of Economic Interest is required upon employment.
